Dear Parent/Carer,

I write to you during what are very exceptional and challenging times for everyone. As a school community, we are thankful for the incredible work that all key workers have been doing over the last few weeks and continue to do.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your patience and support in encouraging your son/daughter to engage in online learning. This has been a challenge for staff, pupils and parents to move to this way of working. I also thank the staff for their efforts in providing online learning materials to allow our pupils to continue with their education. The work has been outstanding considering how little time there was to get things up and running.

We do not know how long it will be before the school can physically reopen so we must continue to plan for digital learning to take place and for our pupils to move to the next phase/stage of their learning. As a school community, we set aspirational targets for all of our pupils and we need you to help them to achieve these.
